## Decalogue of actions to align with Cost strategic policy

- ✓ To **grow EIC/ITC leadership**. Our next two meetings will be held in ITC centers and will be organized by ECIs. Aiming to allow networking between CA17112 participants and local scientists.
- ✓ **Setting up an ECI forum** for further developing leadership skills.
- ✓ **Provide mentorship to ECIs particularly from ITCs.** Preparing them to be actively involved in future cross-border multi-centre, multi-disciplinary studies. Our strategy is to challenge ECI participants to lead work-packages or specific CA17112 projects.
- ✓ To assist in the development of ECIs through education and capacity building: to support ECI participants from ITC countries to attend and present at the EASL Conference; further organization of clinical and basic STSMs which attracts their participation. The next TS will be on Regulatory issues in Liver safety and is organized by ECIs. We will encourage ECI oral presentations and look to incorporate poster sessions into our future CA17112 meetings.
- ✓ Establish links with Regulatory agencies to initiate training programs.
- ✓ Update website (<a href="https://proeurodilinet.eu/">https://proeurodilinet.eu/</a>) to advertise funding opportunities and open a public page run by ECIs
- ✓ Organizing a one-day **Drug-induced liver injury Monothematic**Conference alongside the Eurotox society annual meeting, and an INFO

  DAY, primarily organized by ECI participants within the action.
- ✓ **Reach out** to other liver groups (NAFLD, AIH)/societies (AASLD, EASL, EUROTOX, EFPIA, BJP, EACPT, Pediatrics, Transplant Organizations) and other CA to address the challenges we face in DILI.
- ✓ Ensuring strong representation of ECIs and gender balance on all Committees/WGs.
- ✓ The setting of principles to ensure family-friendly practices within the CA and a woman-friendly environment.
