CONFERENCE SERIES ON DILI M NEW INSIGHTS: YOUNG INVESTIGATORS SEMINAR SERIES M NEW INSIGHTS:

In order to support young investigator's career development and to encourage interactions among the participants in the COST Action 17112, we are launching a New Insights: Young Investigators Seminar Series.

We propose this as a series of talks, ONCE monthly, given by early career investigators (ECIs) - with the supervision of their tutors (both hosts and mentors). The outline of the session would be a brief introduction of the speaker by the mentor, a talk around 45 min with 15 min left for discussion. Conferences will be held the 3rd Thursday of each month at 16.30h (CET).

NEW RESEARCH TOPIC IN DRUG THERAPY FOR DRUG INDUCED LIVER INJURY

The COST ACTION WG4 is currently making a SERIES OF SYSTEMATIC reviewS about the different therapies used in the management and prevention of DILI. Frontiers in Pharmacology is interested in publishing a RESEARCH TOPIC IN DRUG THERAPY FOR DILI. The objective is to REVISE all the information available in journals in order to finally define the best clinical trial design and outcome measures for the evaluation of novel therapies. Many drugs have been used in DILI treatment without a clear evidence of eficacy. However, in most published studies proper conclusions on the role of a given drug in preventing or treating DILI can not be drawn because of the limitations of the design used as well as the small sample size. The aim of this special issue is to carry out an in-dept review of the literature to investigate the the role of every agent (marketed drug as well as novel therapies), which has been used in treating and preventing DILI. This collection of articles will serve as the basis of well new designed randomized clinical trial for DILI management.
